



Gas Day Harmonisation

Denison Gas Transition Plan

Version 1.0

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Denison Gas outlines its compliance procedure with the Gas Day Harmonisation (GDH) Transition Plan as Operator of the Yellowbank and Rolleston Gas Plants. The plan aligns the reporting of Denison Gas Production Facilities with the East Coast Gas Market start time of 6:00am AEST from 1 October 2019.

Obligations

As a production facility Operator, Denison Gas is required to implement the *standard gas day* from 1 Oct 2019. The standard nomination timetables apply to certain transport facilities (including the QGP) and gas Bulletin Board reporting.

Connections / Metering

Denison Gas facilities are interconnected with the Queensland Gas Pipeline (QGP) which is affected by the GDH. The connections are operated by Jemena Ltd and the transition plan is outlined in Jemena's *Gas Day Harmonisation: Transition Plan Public*, 28 June 2019.

Denison Gas has identified that the key metering systems which require adjusted reporting are both operated by Jemena. There are no metering systems that Denison Gas is responsible for reconfiguring under the rules.

Facilities

The Rolleston facility will be connected to the QGP via the upgraded Rolleston Junction connection. The production facility is currently shut in and undergoing refurbishment. The GDH affects the restart of this facility in 2020. Future binding gas supply contracts that may be entered into by Denison Gas will reflect the new gas day start time,

The Yellowbank facility connects to the QGP via the Westgrove Junction metering system. Denison Gas will amend its nominations procedure with its 3rd party gas purchaser to reflect the revised schedule. Denison Gas will also seek amendment to its private supply contracts to ensure they are aligned with nominations and the *standard gas day*.

Short Gas Day Nomination – 30 September 2019

Denison Gas will ensure it operates consistently with the AEMO guiding principles. Nominations for the short gas day of 30 September 2019 will reflect the short gas day duration of 22 hours. The 2 hours from 6am to 8am will be included in the next gas day (1 October 2019)
